Market Colour

Buying opportunities with recent sell-off

We believe the recent sell-off may have created attractive entry points for investors. Among STI components that have been under selling pressure this week included Genting Singapore (-3.8% WoW), UOL (-3.6% WoW), ComfortDelGro (-3.0% WoW), CapitaLand (-2.6% WoW) and Sembcorp Industries (-2.3% WoW). Given the lack of any short-term upside catalysts in local markets, equities may continue to trade-range bound going into the quiet year-end period. We expect risk appetite to return next quarter in view of our thesis that global economic growth will continue in 2018. Our top calls for 2018 are 1) EU and Japanese stocks; 2) long Chinese large-caps (A50)/short small-caps; 3) long US technology, industrials and financials; and 4) long oil / short base metals.

News

Singapore market performance

Banks led the broad market in November, with DBS, OCBC and UOB averaging 6% gains over the month. DBS has overtaken SingTel to claim the highest market capitalisation among SGX-listed stocks. Year-to-date, the three banks have averaged a 40% YoY gains in wealth management fee income, which has helped to drive stronger-than-expected earnings growth. REITs were the second best performing sector in November, with two new IPOs that made their debut – Keppel-KBS US REIT and Cromwell European REIT.

According to SGX data, institutional investors net bought (+S\$116.4m) in November, vs. (+S\$509.7m) in October. Financials (+S\$418.8m), Industrials (+S\$86.3m), and Consumer Discretionary (+S\$43.6m) were the top net buy sectors. Among notable stocks which saw heavy institutional buying included Genting Singapore (net buy +S\$89m) and SIA (net buy +S\$39m) after they both reported stronger YoY earnings.

What to watch out for in the next few weeks

The US tax-reform bill moving faster-than-expected over the past weeks has influenced markets, with Republicans expecting to pass it before Christmas. Markets are expecting that the deep cuts to corporate tax rates will help further drive earnings of companies. On a fundamental basis, the US economy is still picking up pace, and remains the best performer among developed countries. Concerns over possible inverted yield curve hurting the economy are overdone, in our view.
