## Market Colour

**Buying opportunities.** The 4-5% decline over the past three trading days in global equities has created buying opportunities. Looking at fundamentals, rising interest rates and steepening yield curves due to accelerating global economic growth is actually good news. We would pick up many of the blue-chip stocks that have retraced back to Nov/Dec-17 levels: Keppel Corp, Capitaland, Ascendas REIT, SingTel, Venture and Genting Singapore.

**Current sell-off a normal exchange of liquidity; rise in volatility should not warrant panic.** Since February 2016, US stocks have led a bull run without a meaningful correction. In that sense, the market is surprised that such a pullback would take this long to occur. The S&P 500 Volatility Index (VIX) kept dipping to lows in the past year as no risk factors seemed to trigger caution. Hence, big tech names, such as Microsoft, Google, and Apple, have reported disappointing results, which has helped spur selling activity. Though we should point out that despite some misses from major companies, 78% of reported earnings have beat expectations. And while VIX has surged, the CBOE SKEW Index (also known as 'black swan' index) is down, indicating a perception that even though volatility is up, the risk of tail events remains low.
